1.0 INTRODUCTION

The Client (Ministry of ICT, Innovation and Youth Affairs, State Department of ICT & Innovation) organized a Pre-Tender Site Survey on 19th August 2021. This was to give the Bidders an opportunity to familiarize with the ground requirements, understand the Tender drawings and identify the omission, adjustments to be considered to ensure installed solution meets the expectation of the intended work.

Having gone through the site survey the following issues were raised through the e-mail and addressed as follows:

2.0 ISSUES AND CLARIFICATIONS

Are we allowed to quote for extra works and if yes? This means we will have to draft our own price schedule/quotation. Is this allowed4. Fiber pig tails and the quantities are not captured in the tender BOQ's - Kindly advise and clarify.5. Knock outs and the quantities are not captured in the tender BOQ's - Kindly advise and clarify.6. During the site survey's we realized that there are some Hospitals with building's and equipment's not captured in the tender drawing's and BOQ's - Kindly advise and clarify.	<p>The missing drawings in the Tender Documents Section V part 18 have been amended by including all of them as indicated in section 5 of each specific Tender addendum.</p> <p>The Bill of Materials and Price Schedule has been amended accordingly to reflect the new requirements as specified in section 3.0 and section 4.0 of each specific Tender addendum.</p>

4.	Can we submit the application documentation for the renewal of CA and NCA certificates? This is because the application for renewal of the Communication Authority (CA) takes about 60 days). One can only initiate renewal after expiry of the certificate and we are waiting from June.	The bidding document clearly stipulates that the bidder submits valid NCA certificate and valid certificate from the Communication Authority and not application documents for renewal.

Local Area Network Installation, sub-section “4.1 Self-cooling Cabinet with a Power Solution”. This cabinet is not in any of the BOQ’s. Are we expected to complete its compliance if we are not supplying it?</p>	The floor cabinets and the MDF Cabinet shall be as specified in this addendum and specific Tender addendum for self-cooling Cabinet.

10.	Metal Trunking 1. The tender BOQ's are specific on the Galvanized Metallic Trunking 150mm x50mm & accessories for installing Data Points and we recommend powder coated off-white or white Metallic Trunking of the same measurements to match the Hospital walls - Kindly advise and clarify.	The metal trunking must comply to specifications as specified in Section V, section 6.1 on LAN Installation.

3.0 18U NETWORK CABINET

The bidder shall provide floor/block cabinets with features as follows;

Requirements			
1.	Floor/ Block cabinets shall be metallic and wall mounted with front clear glass at least 18U and of good finish and conveniently accessible by technical personnel for		

	maintenance.		
2.	Power to the cabinets shall be switched off from within the cabinets. Proper power socket cables to be supplied with the cabinets. The bidder shall be required to provide at least a 4-way Power Distribution Unit (PDU) outlet per 24 user data points.		
3.	All cabinets shall have at least 4U free space after all the passive and active equipment are mounted		
4.	Each cabinet shall be identified by using an agreed name (a, b, c, d etc) or as on services drawing.		
5.	Each cabinet shall electric A.C. fans shall be placed in the cabinet to keep the active components cool		
6.	Each cabinet shall be equipped with a roof mounted 4 fan cooling fan tray		
7.	All cabinets must have forced cooling.		
8.	The exact placing of the cabinets should be defined at the start of the works by the bidder in consultation with the facility in charge/ administration		
9.	The cabinets must provide enough space to accommodate cabling, cabling management, equipment racks, patch panels and network control devices as required with convenient locations to provide access to operational personnel.		
10.	The UPS installed in the floor/block cabinet shall be 1500VA for the 18U cabinet, rack mountable, SMART signalling and line interactive.		
11.	Doors should be equipped with a locking system		
12.	It should have a 1-year Warranty
